

Stop the 3rd runway!

> Six grounds for denying approval

Federal Transport Minister Catherine King MP, can deny approval of the proposed Melbourne Airport Third Runway (M3R) Major Development Plan (MDP), now being assessed, because of its serious negative health, environmental and climate impacts.

#1 Lack of an independent health & environment impacts study

> Melbourne Airport has not released an independent study of M3Rs projected environmental and health impacts, including those experienced from existing noise levels.

#2 Maximum safe noise levels exceeded

> Melbourne Airport refuses to acknowledge harmful landing and takeoff noise exceeding W.H.O. maximum safety levels.

#3 Loss of protected habitat and species

> Woodland & endangered species habitat will be clear felled, despite federal Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation (EPBC) Act.

#4 Actual emissions 50 times greater than reported

> Melbourne Airport counts only M3R landing and takeoff CO2 emissions, ignoring full flight and non-CO2 emissions.

#5 Non-compliance with the Climate Change 2022 Act

> Melbourne Airport has not explained how third runway emissions will comply with the Climate Change 2022 Act.

#6 MDP not based on an approved Master Plan

> Runway plans are meant to be based on approved Master Plans. But the MDP was created, *five months before* the Master Plan was approved.
